

The Erasmus+ ICM Program to visit The University Of Gla

I have visited James Watt School of Engineering at University of Glasgow on the 6th of August, 2019 under the ERASMUS+ICM Project which is recently signed between University of Duhok and Glasgow University in Scotland-UK.

The main goal of this program is to create sustainable research collaboration between the University of Duhok visitor and host professors at University of Glasgow. Accordingly, I met with Dr Lukasz Kaczmarczyk and Dr Peter Grassl, who are members of Glasgow Computational Engineering Centre (GCEC), to establish plans for performing future research study. They agreed to work on a research entitled “**Homogenization of Hybrid Concrete Members**” which deals with modeling of hybrid concrete using cohesive elements. In addition, I have been discussed with Dr. Lukasz to work on a research grant application and possibility of hosting future split-site PhD students of structural engineering at Glasgow University and the University of Duhok.
