

PROGRAM OVERVIEW: BSC IN SPATIAL PLANNING

Study Duration:

The program is organized in **4 years**:

- The 4 years are dedicated for Spatial Planning courses with a BSc Thesis.

Program Contents:

The study is organised according to the Bologna process and it has **24 Modules (240 credit points)**.

Acceptance Criteria:

Minimum accepted 12th grade Average: **80%**, with the total **grades of English having 20% weight and Math having 10% weight**.

Tuition Fees:

- Studying in this program is completely **FREE**.
- Students only need to pay fees for the **Summer School in Germany**.

Summer School in Germany:

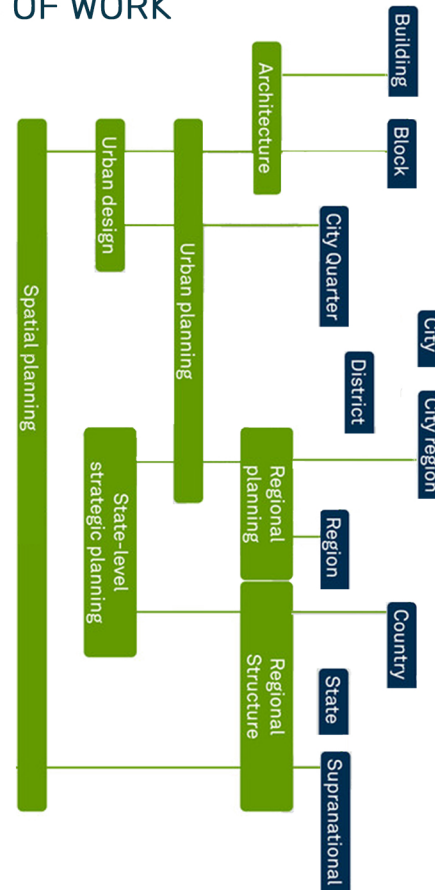
As part of the program, students during their 6th Academic semester (the 3rd stage) are accompanied by supervisors to attend the Summer School Program studying

Joint Degree:

The program has a shared Module Manual, Joint Exam Regulations and the **"Joint Certificate"** in Bachelor of Science in Spatial Planning, offered by the University of Duhok and the Technical University of Dortmund.

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WHAT IS SPATIAL PLANNING

Spatial planning is an interdisciplinary field in the engineering and social sciences that deals with the spatial arrangement and development of living, working and environmental conditions at a wide range of spatial levels.

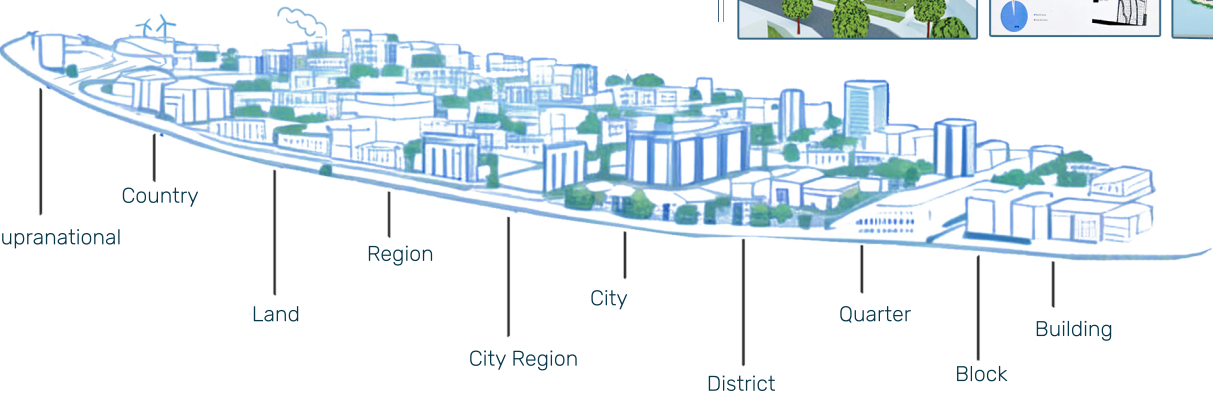
The different spatial levels range from the built environment and residential quarters to the urban district, the city as a whole, the region, the state and even the international levels.

THE PROGRAM

The goal and outcome of the 3-year DAAD funded project (2010, 2011, and 2012) was to establish the joint program of Planing Education in Iraq, in partnership between TU Dortmund and the Univeristy of Duhok and other Iraqi partners.

The goal of the partners was the further development of the "Bachelor Program in Spatial Planning for Iraq" at the University of Duhok, with the ultimate goal being development of this program as a joint degree program between TU Dortmund and the University of Duhok.

The "Spatial Planning" Joint B.Sc. program was established in 2012. As part of the joint program, professors from TU Dortmund are teaching and providing thesis supervision to students. The program has a shared Module Manuel, Joint Exam Regulations and the "Joint Certificate" in Bachelor of Science in Spatial Planning.

Students graduating from this program gain knowledge in different professional fields. These include, among others:

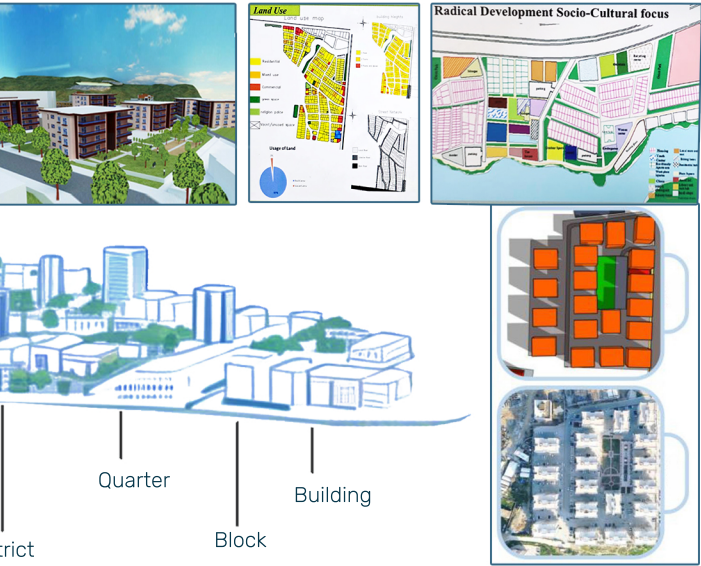
- o Spatial Planning and State planning

SUMMER SCHOOL IN GERMANY

The B.Sc. program consists of a summer school activity in Germany. Students in their 6th academic semester (3rd stage) are accompanied by supervisor lecturers to attend the Summer Program studying "the Planning System in Germany" for 4 weeks in Germany, which holds 18 credit points. The program is part of the joint agreement between the two universities which enables the students to experience the German planning system as well as German higher education with TU Dortmund as exemplary institution of German higher learning.



The experience is a unique one for the students and an outstanding opportunity for cultural and educational exchange. The program begins in TU Dortmund where students attend lectures and excursions about the planning systems in Germany. The program also includes further visits to other German cities in the aim of exploring the State Departments, the History of the Development of German Cities, and Transportation Planning in Germany.
